Myopia Control for Shortsighted Children



Parents often ask if there is any way to slow down or stop their children from becoming more short-sighted (myopic). Most cases of myopia are due to the eyeball 'over-growing' - even half a millimetre causes significant myopia.

It is now known that time spent outdoors is an important factor in some cases and studies are now looking at the quality of light that children are exposed to - in the meantime we would encourage adding an hour or two to your child's daily 'outdoor time'. Recent studies have found that wearing special multi focus soft contact lenses can in many cases retard the speed at which the myopia increases and these comfortable monthly replacement lenses only cost a few pounds a month more than standard monthly lenses. The effect of these lenses is to alter the focus in the periphery of vision which has been found to be a factor which stimulates overgrowth of the eye in myopia.

Blepharitis



What is Blepharitis?

Blepharitis refers to inflammation of the eyelids. Oils and other products normally secreted by the eye and eyelids build up on the lid surface and eyelashes resulting in eye irritation and often redness. It's a common disorder and occurs in two forms:

Anterior Blepharitis - this is when the inflammation affects the outside front edge of your eyelids, where your eyelashes are connected.

Posterior Blepharitis - this is when the inflammation affects the inside front edge of your eyelids, where they come into contact with your eye. This is caused when something affects the glands that are found at the rim of your eyelids, for example skin conditions such as seborrhoeic dermatitis or acne rosacea.

Symptoms are common to both types and can be redness, irritation, burning, crusty eye lids and even blurry vision.

How can we help it?

The best way to help this is regular eye lid hygiene. It should be part of your regular routine. Special heat pads such as an Eyebag can help soften the crusts and soften the blocked glands. Then non detergent cleaning solutions such as Blephaclean can be used to gently remove the crusts.





How long does it take?

Most people will notice an improvement within a week but it can take 3-4 weeks to get the full benefit.
